Hence, 1 point is awarded for segregation of waste at household level , 2 points for contract with recycler is pending. Final Review: The project team has submitted a photograph indicating the distribution of dust bins in the village. However, the process of treatment of waste post collection is unclear. The project team has not submitted any contract with the recycling vendor. Therefore, additional points cannot be awarded under this credit.

Gram Panchayat will levy Rs. 500 penalty on open defecation. Supporting documents includes photographs of the individual toilets and declaration signed by Sarpanch (dated 20/01/2025) of availability of 112 individual toilets, declaration of Blocks as ODF Plus signed by Block Development Officer, Panchayat Koregoan Dist. for the year 2021-2022 and penalty on open defecation. Photographs of the streets. Hence, 1 point is awarded for toilets in more than 50% of household, 2 points for septic tank/public toilet/ cleanliness across livestock/ clean streets/ prevention on mosquito breeding is pending. Technical Advice: Please submit the following: 1. Please submit details of measures taken for installation of Septic tank/ public toilets 2. Photographs showing cleanliness across livestock, clean streets 3. Measures taken for prevention on mosquito breeding 4. Narrative and declaration stating the cleaning of the street and provision of dustbins per 500m in the village streets

However, 2 points are pending. Technical Advice: Please submit the following: 1. Please submit details of total tap connections available in the village providing water taps in 100% of households. 2. Mention the total capacity of the underground tank and overhead tank, further specifying the per capita/day availability of drinking water Final Review: The project team has submitted a photograph of the cement tank with 35000 litres and a declaration letter stating the same. However, the amount of drinking water availability per capita is unclear from the submittals. Therefore, 1 point is awarded under this credit.

Please submit details of provision of public toilets in bus stand, railway station, vegetable mandi or any public space 2. Maintenance record showcasing regular cleaning of public toilets. Final Review: The project team has submitted a declaration letter stating that all 115 households (100%) have provision of individual toilets and these toilets are regularly cleaned; and photographs highlighting some of the individual toilets constructed in the household. This meets the credit requirements. Therefore, 2 points are awarded for 100% provision of individual toilets in all households under this credit.

Photographs showing the maintenance of healthcare facility Final Review: The submittals include a photograph highlighting separate waste bin for bio-medical waste, log sheet, drinking water supply, inverter, a long shot photograph of the healthcare facility in Velu and a declaration letter signed by Sarpanch (dated 20 Oct 2025) stating that the healthcare centre has a doctor and a nurse. However, the disposal process of bio-medical waste is unclear. Therefore, additional 2 points are awarded for drinking water facility and inverter installed in the healthcare centre.

Technical Advice: Please submit the following: 1.Letter from Sarpanch stating that potable water & treated waste water pumps have efficiency of 75% and above and 100% of households have energy meters. Final Review: From the submittals it is observed that the project team has submitted a letter from the vendor stating the procurement of water pumps by the project team from them. However, the efficiency of the water pump is still unclear. Also, the project team has submitted a declaration letter stating that 100% of the households have energy meters installed. Therefore, 1 point is awarded under this credit and 1 point for water pumps cannot be awarded under this credit.
