Supporting documents includes photographs of the waste collection and declaration signed by Sarpanch of wet and kitchen waste handling at 388 household levels. Hence, 1 point is awarded for segregation of waste at household level. Final Review The project team has submitted a declaration letter by Sarpanch (dated 10/11/2025) stating that 2 separate dustbins for wet waste and dry waste are distributed (total 776) in the village with a total household of 388. However, 1 point is awarded for the same during the preliminary review.

The declaration signed by Sarpanch states that the common toilets are cleaned by the staff appointed by the Gram Panchayat. Further, no open defecation is allowed in the village. Gram Panchayat will levy Rs. 500 penalty on open defecation. As regards to the mosquito breeding, the village is taking active measures to conduct fumigation at village level once in every 15 days. Supporting documents includes photographs of the individual toilets and common toilets and declaration signed by Sarpanch of availability of 294 individual toilets. Declaration signed by Sarpanch stating - 1. ODF Plus signed by Block Development Officer, Panchayat Koregoan Dist. for the year 2021-2022 and highlighting penalty on open defecation. 2. Cleaning of common toilets by staff appointed by Gram Panchayat 3. Fumigation done once in 15 days to avoid mosquito breeding Hence, 3 points are awarded.

The village has installed water purifiers and water dispensers which supply drinking water for 1 hour per day. Supporting documents include photographs of the tap, water tanks, water purifier and certificate of safe drinking water. Based on the submission, there is adequate drinking water available. Hence, 2 points are awarded.
					Final Review The submitted declaration letter signed by Sarpanch (dated 10/11/2025) states that total 332 households out of 388 (85%) are connected directly for drinking water supply. Additionally, it states that total 5 tanks are available with a total capacity of 1,70,000 liters. However, the credit points have been awarded in the preliminary review.

Photographs showing the maintenance of healthcare facility Final Review The declaration letter submitted by Sarpanch (dated 10/11/2025) states that 1 doctor is available in PHC at Ugalewadi and another 2 doctors are present at Dimbhe village PHC which is approximately 20-30 mins from Ugalewadi. Also, the submitted photographs indicate that common toilets is available for male & female, drinking water facility, power back-up (inverter). During the in person site audit, IGBC team has observed that 2 staff members were available at the PHC Therefore, additional 2 points are awarded under this credit.
