Hence, 3 points are awarded for segregation of waste at household level and recycling of dry waste. Technical Advice: Please submit the following: 1. Please submit details of the centralised collection & sorting area confirming the segregation of biodegradable waste and recyclable waste (plastic & paper waste). 2. Contract with recyclers for plastic and paper waste Final Review: The project team states that the plastic waste is collected by the recycle vendor. Also, the submittals include a photograph indicating the segregation of waste done on the basis of compost, waste and recycle.
