Supporting documents includes photographs of the waste collection & centralised sorting area and declaration signed by Sarpanch of wet and kitchen waste handling at 294 household levels. Hence, 3 points are awarded for segregation of waste at household level and recycling of dry waste.

Gram Panchayat will levy Rs. 500 penalty on open defecation. As regards to the mosquito breeding, the village is taking active measures to conduct fumigation at village level once in every 15 days. Supporting documents includes photographs of the individual toilets and common toilets and declaration signed by Sarpanch of availability of 294 individual toilets. Declaration signed by Sarpanch stating - 1. ODF Plus signed by Block Development Officer, Panchayat Koregoan Dist. for the year 2021-2022 and highlighting penalty on open defecation. 2. Cleaning of common toilets by staff appointed by Gram Panchayat 3. Fumigation done once in 15 days to avoid mosquito breeding Hence, 3 points are awarded.

Photographs showing the maintenance of healthcare facility
					Final Review: The project team has submitted multiple photographs of primary health care centre in the village. However, the number of doctors available, segregation of bio-medical waste and separate toilets provision is unclear.

Supporting documents includes photographs of the play area and toilets. hence 3 points are awarded for provision of Primary school with basic facilities such as toilets and playground. Technical Advice: Please submit the following: 1. Please submit photographs showing writing desks and connected drinking water supply. Final Review: The project team has responded to the technical advice raised during the preliminary review by submitting photographs of the drinking water facility in ZP school along with the writing desks made available for students. Also, during the in-person site visit, IGBC team has observed the drinking water facility and the writing desks available for the school students. This meets the credit requirement. Therefore, additional 2 points are awarded under this credit.

However, the following points are noted: 1. Lighting in the bus stop is not clearly visible 2. No supporting documents for Intra village commuting facilities are submitted Therefore, 1 point is awarded for bus stop with shelter and seating and 1 point is ascertained with a benefit of doubt for this project only considering that the project team must have made provision for lighting either in the bus stop or a street light must be available next to bus stop. <i>Note: For future submissions, the project team shall submit photographs of lighting as well to meet the credit compliance.</i>

Final Review: The submittals include a photograph indicating the well and a water tank supplying water to the entire village. It also includes a declaration letter signed by the Gramsevak stating that 274 out of 294 households have direct connection of water supply. The declaration also states that each individual in every household receives 70 litres of water per day. However the project team has not submitted the water test reports indicating the compliance with CWC standards. Therefore, the credit points cannot be awarded under this credit.

Therefore, 1 point is awarded for the periodic plantation and 1 point is ascertained with a benefit of doubt for this project only considering that at least 20% of the village shall be covered with green cover, excluding agricultural land. <i>Note: For future submissions, the project team shall submit the calculation indicating the percentage of village under green cover, excluding agricultural land to meet the credit compliance.</i>
