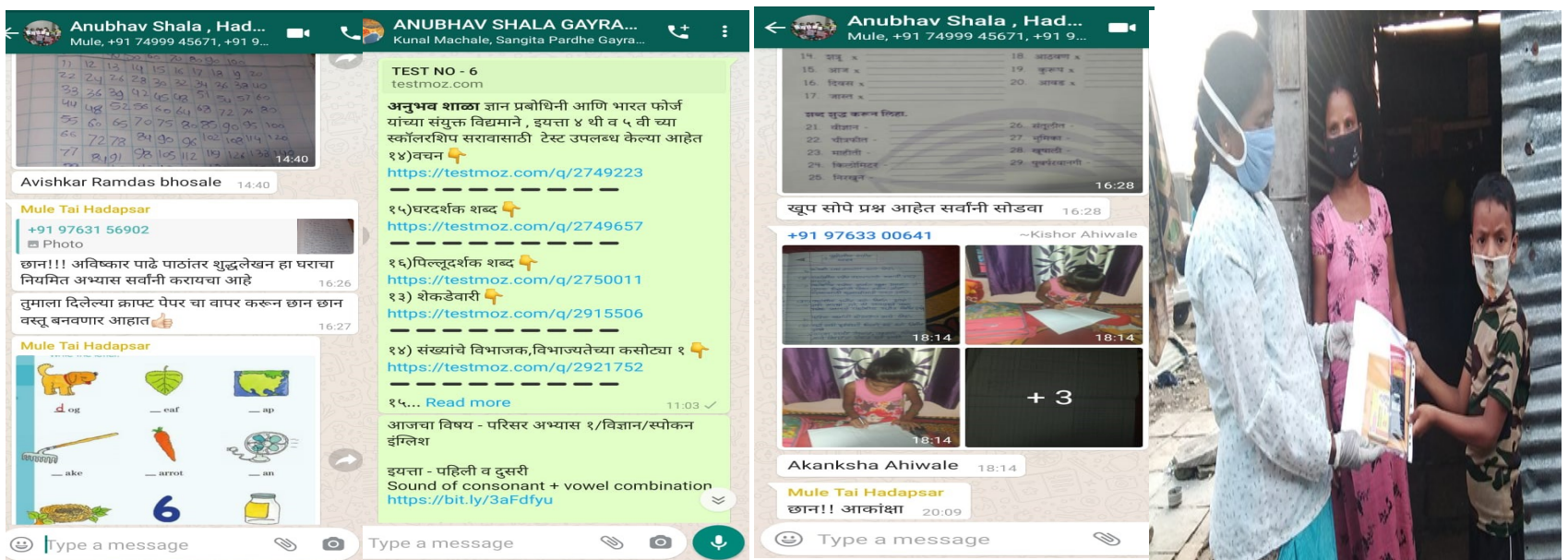
Sessions on mental maths, story telling, essay writing, English grammar, puzzles, etc. were imparted to 70 children through virtual platform during pandemic.

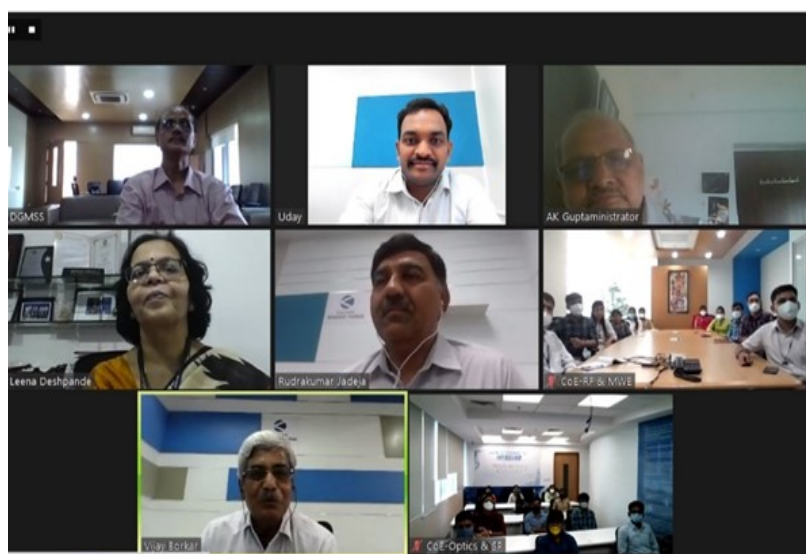

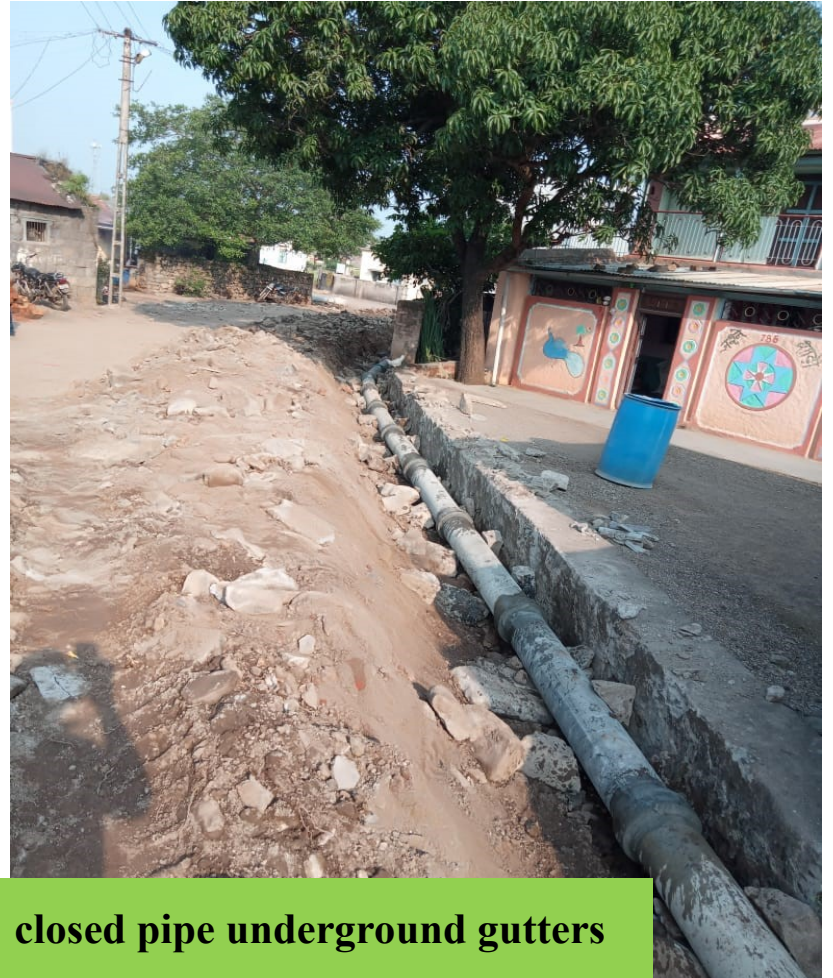
