British Era Policing Over, Data is New Science, says Shah

New Delhi: Union home minister Amit Shah said the days of British era policing are over, as he stressed on the importance of using hig data in policing.

"Data is the new science and big data is the solution to all problems this should become the thumb rule for all police forces," Shah said on Friday, addressing the gathering at the inauguration of the 48th All India Police Science Congress in Bhopal. "The time of British era danda (baton) based policing is over. Now, it's imperative that policing is done on the basis of knowledge, evidence and logic. We have to change the science of policing."

The minister said, "Police need to be tech-savvy to remain two steps ahead of criminals. We need to discuss both aspects of police science, which comprises science for police and science of police."

Shah highlighted the ways in which scientific processes have been helping in maintaining law and order in the country. He said there were lingering problems such as the Kashmir issue, left-wing extremism, narcotics and armed groups in the Northeast that continued to be a threat to internal security. "Modi government addressed all these issues scientifically and took measures diligently," he said.

The minister also said that since the abrogation of Article 370, in August 2019, large-scale development is happening in Jammu and Kashmir. Talking about left-wing extremism, Shah said, "In a state like

Madhya Pradesh, left-wing extremism is almost over." Madhya Pradesh chief minister Shivraj Singh said, "MP Police has taken action against different types of mafia and managed to free land worth about Rs 12,000 crore in the past two years. We have decided to use this land for the poor and for various other purposes."The two-day event is being held at the Central Academy of Police Training in Bhopal where papers will be presented on various themes, including policing during the pan demic, skills of investigators and aid of technology, law and order processes, human resource management and wellness, leadership mentoring and mental health stress ma nagement, and prison processes and good practices.

Underlining the need to modernise the police force, Union Home Minister Amit Shah on Friday advised the police personnel to become tech-savvy in order to remain two steps ahead of criminals.

He was speaking at the inauguration of the 48th All India Police Science Congress (AIPSC) organised by the Bureau of Police Research and Development (BPR&I) here.

"Police need to be techsavvy to remain two steps ahead of criminals," he said.

Mr. Shah added that there was a need to modernise and train the police force in order to strengthen the country's internal security.

The Minister said that in the



last eight years, the Narendra Modi government has almost settled the Kashmir issue, and also resolved Naxalism and narocotics problem in the North East region. "After the abrogation of Article 370, large-scale development is happening in Jammu and Kashmir," he said.

The two-day event is being held at the Central Academy of Police Training (CAPT) in Bhopal. Madhya Pradesh Chief Minister Shivraj Singh Chouhan also spoke on the occasion.

The main objective of the programme is to provide a common platform to various police forces, units, social scientists, forensic experts and other stakeholders to deliberate on selected themes of topical interests to the Indian police, an official said.

For the first time, the AIPSC is being attended by police forces, units, social scientists, forensic experts and stakeholders along with the officers of the department of correctional administration, he said.

For this, the police will have to be techno-savvv and master the use of technology at every beat, head constable, constable level, otherwise we will not be able to control new types of crimes. For this BPR&D has provided a platform. Work is being done in this direction in the last ten years through various training sessions. All India Police Science Congress is important for the internal challenges of the country and ensuring security and such events are necessary.

that there are challenges before the country like drugs, hawala transactions, cyber fraud. A person sitting in one state can indulge in cyber fraud with a person from another state. There is no common strategy to deal with such cases. What is the medium of communication for resolving such cases? The Police Science Congress is the ideal system for these situations, BPR&D is essential to find solutions by bringing police from across the country on one platform to face similar challenges. It is, therefore, necessary that the Police Science Congress should also

discuss in a special session the determination of a common strategy to meet similar challenges.
