# British Era Policing Over, Data is New Science, says Shah

**New Delhi:** Union home minister Amit Shah said the days of British era policing are over, as he stressed on the importance of using big data in policing.

"Data is the new science and big data is the solution to all problems - this should become the thumb rule for all police forces," Shah said on Friday, addressing the gathering at the inauguration of the 48th All India Police Science Congress in Bhopal. "The time of British era danda (baton)-based policing is over. Now, it's imperative that policing is done on the basis of knowledge, evidence and logic. We have to change the science of policing."

The minister said, "Police need to be tech-savvy to remain two steps ahead of criminals. We need to discuss both aspects of police science, which comprises science for police and science of police."

Shah highlighted the ways in which scientific processes have been helping in maintaining law and order in the country. He said there were lingering problems such as the Kashmir issue, left-wing extremism, narcotics and armed groups in the Northeast that continued to be a threat to internal security. "Modi government addressed all these issues scientifically and took measures diligently," he said.

The minister also said that since the abrogation of Article 370, in August 2019, large-scale development is happening in Jammu and Kashmir.

Talking about left-wing extremism, Shah said, "In a state like

Madhya Pradesh, left-wing extremism is almost over." Madhya Pradesh chief minister Shivraj Singh said, "MP Police has taken action against different types of mafia and managed to free land worth about Rs 12,000 crore in the past two years. We have decided to use this land for the poor and for various other purposes." **Remarks against Maha CM: HC restrains cops from arresting Rane**

Granting an interim protection to Union minister Narayan Rane, the Bombay High Court on Friday ordered that no coercive action be taken against him for two weeks in connection with the first information report (FIR) registered against him by the Dhule Police.

The FIR was registered over Mr Rane's alleged derogatory statement against chief minister Uddhav Thackeray in August for allegedly making derogatory statements against Chief Minister Uddhav Thackeray in 2021.

Last week, Dhule police issued a notice to Mr Rane asking to appear before them for investigation.

The Union minister moved the High Court seeking quashing of the FIR. In his petition, Mr Rane also informed the court that the Dhule police issued a notice under section 41A of the CrPC, which allows the investigating officer to seek the appearance of the accused before arresting him.

In another case registered in Nashik over the same statement, Nashik police had made a statement on August 25, 2021 that no coercive action would be taken against Mr Rane.

Giving examples, Minister Shah said that different CCTVs are being installed by the residents' associations, municipal corporations, market associations in the cities.
